**\*\* All students have P.E. and need to wear appropriate clothing and tennis shoes on their designated days \*\***

### **Kindergarten**

Supplies will be community supplies and used by all students. Therefore, we are requesting \$20.00 per student so we are able to purchase items that are alike.

\* Each student should have their own backpack labeled with child's name.

\*Tennis Shoes are recommended. If child cannot tie their own shoes, then please purchase Velcro tennis shoes.

\*Each child should have a full change of clothes each day in their backpack.

### **1st Grade**

Supplies will be community supplies and used by all students. Therefore, we are requesting \$20.00 per student so we are able to purchase items that are alike.

\* Each student should have their own backpack labeled with child's name

### **2nd Grade**

Supplies will be community supplies and used by all students. Please choose one of the following options for classroom supplies. We are asking for these specific supplies because they all need to be alike.

\* Each student should have their own backpack.

#### **Option 1**

- 24 #2 plain pencils
- 2 24-count boxes of **Crayola** crayons
- 4 large boxes of tissue
- 4 large glue sticks
- 4 soft pink erasers
- 1 box of full length **Crayola** colored pencils
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 1 white 2" view binder

### **3rd Grade**

Supplies will be community supplies and used by all students. Therefore, we are requesting \$20.00 per student so we are able to purchase items that are alike. Each student should have their own:

- 1 backpack
- 3 pocket folders to go in 3-ring binder
- 1 1 inch, 3-ring binder
- 1 pencil pouch for 3-ring binder
- 1 pair scissors
- 1 package (150 sheets) wide ruled notebook paper
- 2 boxes of tissue

### **4th Grade**

Each student needs a backpack, a 2 inch, 3-ring binder, 1 set of dividers for the binder and a pencil pouch or pencil box; labeled with their name. Supplies will be community supplies and used by all students, so please do not label the following:

- 36 #2 led pencils with erasers (highest quality)
- 2 glue sticks
- 4 large pink erasers
- 1000 sheets of wide ruled notebook paper
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 box colored markers
- 8 blue ballpoint ink pens
- 8 red ballpoint ink pens
- 8 wide ruled, spiral notebooks (70 pages each)
- 1 12" ruler with both metric and standard units of measure
- 3 large boxes of tissue
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer, 8 oz or larger

### **5th Grade**

Supplies will be community supplies and used by all students. Please choose one of the following options for classroom supplies. We are asking for these specific supplies because they all need to be alike. \* Each student should have their own backpack.

#### **Option 1**

- 2 glue sticks, Elmer's brand (no liquid glue)
- 1 ruler with both metric and standard
- 6 spiral notebooks
- 1 box colored pencils, **Crayola** brand, 12 count
- 1 box fine tip markers, **Crayola** brand
- 1 box wide tip markers, **Crayola** brand
- 1 box crayons, **Crayola** brand, 24 count
- 6 plain folders, pocket only, 6 different colors
- 96 #2 pencils
- 1 protractor
- 500 sheets notebook paper, college ruled
- 3 large boxes of tissue
- 1 water bottle
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer, 8 oz. minimum
