

First Creek Middle School - 6th Grade Supply List

The following list of items is provided to assist you in planning for the start of school. Students need the first three items the first day of school. The other items may be brought to school later in the week. In addition, there are a limited number of items that may be specific to a subject area or teacher. Your student will bring this information home or you may check the teacher's website for specifics. For example: art students have an art fee. If you have a question regarding supplies please check with your student's teacher.

- One three-ring binder (2 inch preferred) with subject dividers
- Loose-leaf college rule paper – three hole punched, left margin (needed all year)
- 2 packs of pencils **NO MECHANICAL PENCILS PLEASE** (needed all year)
- 2 blue or black pens, erasable ink pens preferred
- one pencil pouch
- 4 composition books (2 for science and 2 for math)
- 4 spiral notebooks for Humanities (single subject, 70 sheet spirals are fine)
- Ruler – 6 or 12 inch with standard and metric measures
- Glue stick
- Erasers – pencil top or pink pearl style
- Color pencils (8-12 count)
- Two red pens or pencils
- Four Highlighters – one pink, one yellow, one blue, and one green for Humanities
- One pair school scissors – nice to have but not required
- One box of Kleenex (give to first period teacher during first week)
- Book covers are required for all texts and may be made from paper grocery sacks or purchased
- PE uniforms may be purchased from the school
- A back pack or book bag to protect materials during transport between home and school
- **NO SHARPIE PENS OR LIQUID WHITE OUT ARE ALLOWED AT SCHOOL. THESE ITEMS WILL BE CONFISCATED IF BROUGHT.**
- Hand held pencil sharpener

Students need a dictionary, ruler, and a small calculator for homework. Also, please assist your student in applying for a Tacoma Public Library Card. Middle School students will have research projects, reports, and assorted assignments where access to the public library could be helpful. Also, students should have a reading book with them at all times.

Please check with your student periodically throughout the school year to ensure he/she has an adequate supply of paper, pencils, and pens.
