Dress Code 2011 - 2012

The purpose of the school dress code is to:

- *Provide a means of identification and belonging to Baker Middle School
- *Provide for a neat and orderly appearance appropriate for school
- *Avoid competition in dress

Clothing Item	Color	Description
Shirts	Maroon Gold	*Baker Middle School logo required - No other logos are acceptable *Long sleeves or short sleeves *No bare midriffs *No pinning or tying shirts *The length must not extend past the fingertips when hands are extended at the sides, or the shirt <u>will be required</u> to be tucked in and belted.
Hoodies		*Baker Middle School ASB designed hoodies only - No other logos are acceptable *No hoods may be worn while in the building *Only first or last names may be printed on the back. NO nicknames are allowed.
Sweatshirts	Black White Navy	*Plain colored crew neck sweatshirt
Undershirts		Bottom hem may not extend past the bottom hem of the logo t-shirt and sleeve length must be the same
Pants Shorts Capris	Solid Tan Solid Navy	*No denim fabric/jeans, sweats, fleece, nylon or spandex fabric *NO skinny pants or leggings *Must be worn at the waist, loose fitted, but no larger than one size up *Shorts must be no more than three inches above the knee *No cargo pants or painter/carpenter pants *Hems must be neatly and securely stitched *No skirts allowed
Shoes/socks		*Athletic or dress *All shoes must have heel straps or backs *No flip flops, sports sandals, slippers or moccasins *Socks need to be solid white or black only (if showing)
Jewelry and Accessories		*Belts must be worn through the loops, be solid in color and cannot hang down *No spikes, dog collars, chains, bandanas, doo-rags, gloves, leather collars or wrist/head bands allowed *No rubber bands will be worn at the bottom of pants
Hats		*Absolutely no hats are to be worn in the building
Outerwear		*Coats and other outerwear must be stored in lockers (coats may be worn during lunchtime only)

Our Baker Middle School uniform is intentionally conservative to help students focus on learning. It also contributes to our safe and orderly school environment. Students must dress appropriately and according to school rules. Students must arrive and leave each day in uniform. Students who do not comply with the Baker uniform will face consequences.

All Baker staff/administrators/parents are responsible for monitoring and enforcing dress standard compliance.
