

Franklin Uniform Policy 2010-2011

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| SHIRTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · polo shirts, turtlenecks, or dress shirts/blouses with collars · official Franklin T-shirts · shirts must be appropriately sized, only one size larger for growth · No tank tops or sleeveless tops · NO white undershirts worn as outer wear · Shirts or blouses longer than hip or pocket length, must be tucked in · COLORS: navy blue, red, light blue , white or Franklin Apparel |
| LONG PANTS, SKIRTS, SKORTS, SHORTS, OVERALLS, CAPRIS AND JUMPERS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · fabric will be twill, corduroy or denim (long pants only), not sweatpants · fabric must be free of all decorations (sequins, embroidery, etc.) · shorts and skirts must be longer than the end of the fingers · must be worn at the waist with looseness of no more than one inch, and with a belt if needed (no sagging) · standard width leg with hemmed bottom · length must be to top of shoe so pants do not touch floor · COLORS: navy blue, black, khaki or denim |
| SWEATSHIRTS, VESTS, OR SWEATERS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · COLORS: navy blue, red, light blue, white or Franklin Apparel |
| SOCKS AND SHOES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · preferably sneaker-type, NO roller shoes · low-heels only, for safety reasons · sandals must have a heel strap · socks and shoes must be worn to P.E. classes |
| BELTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Belts must be worn in belt loops |
| GENERAL APPEARANCE | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · hair styles should not be distracting · hair must be clean, neat, and not dyed in unnatural colors · facial make-up is not allowed · stickers or drawings on the skin are not allowed |

Franklin Elementary School is proud of our success in the school wide uniform policy. Uniforms reduce peer pressure to out dress each other, are less expensive than trendy fashions and many students behave better when wearing school dress.

All students registered on the 1st day of school will be in school uniform. All students registering after school begins will be given 1 week to conform to the uniform policy. Extra school uniforms will not be used for wet clothing due to weather, lunchroom or hygiene issues. **Parents will be notified.**

What happens when students are not in uniform?
 Student will call parent to have a change of clothes brought to them, and a note will be sent home. If students have been provided a uniform from the uniform closet and noncompliance continues; loss of recess or extra activity privileges may result.
