Dress Code

Clothing at school may not detract from or interfere with a safe and appropriate elementary learning environment; therefore:

- No sweatbands, halter tops, bare mid-riff tops or other revealing attire
- No clothing with profanity or messages about alcohol, drugs or sex
- No hats, do-rags or sunglasses allowed to be worn inside the building
- Coats should be kept in lockers
- No 'sagging' jeans, slacks, shorts, etc. Pants must be worn at the waist. Shorts/dresses/skirts must pass the 'hand test' for length (must be past end of fingertips when arms are along sides of body)
- No attire which disrupts the learning environment
- No swapping or exchanging clothes with friends at school
- No Spandex except with a large or oversized top
- No shower shoes, slip on shoes or **sandals without a heel strap (NO FLIP-FLOPS)**

Geiger staff retains the right to determine if clothing is appropriate according to this dress code. This dress code may be modified at any time by Geiger administration. Students may be required to change or to contact a parent for pick up before being allowed to complete the school day.
