

Student Uniform Dress Standards at Jason Lee Middle School, 2011-2012

Our goal is to provide an atmosphere for safety, civility, and learning in which no one is distracted by the appearance of our students. The required clothing is available at numerous local stores; please ask our office staff if you need assistance obtaining clothing for your children.

<p>Polo Shirts and Official Jason Lee T-Shirts</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid polo shirt colors: grey, black, white or kaki (beige-light brown) only • If t-shirts are worn under approved shirts, they must be plain white only and undershirt sleeves may not hang out below the sleeves of the outer shirt • Solid color turtlenecks, or sweaters of the same colors as above are also allowed • Polo shirts (short or long sleeved) or official Jason Lee T-shirts must be worn at all times throughout the school day • Official Jason Lee T-shirts (available through our School Store or ASB) may be worn under polo shirts, or alone • Athletic clothing may not be worn outside of P.E. class, except on special occasions, as sanctioned by the school • Polo shirts must have 2-5 buttons with collars • No tying of shirt tails, or other alteration of normal wearing is allowed • Shirts must be appropriately sized
<p>Long pants, skirts, shorts, capris, and jumpers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fabric must be cotton twill or corduroy in grey, black, or kaki (beige-light brown) only-no denim, nylon, spandex, or "jeggings". If leggings (not allowed to be worn by themselves) are worn under skirts or short, they must be the same colors as above • Must be fitted, plain in style, and hemmed neatly. No adornments, tears, thread bare material (patches, holes, stripes, or any other decorations) and no sagging • If worn, belts must be worn in the provided belt loops and the belt tail also needs to be held by the belt loops on the garment and may not hang loose. • The length of the shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be no higher than 2" above the top of the kneecap. • If shorts are chosen, they must be hemmed and sized to prevent sagging
<p>Sweatshirts and outerwear</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid-colored (no logos, no alterations) crew-neck, sleeved sweatshirts in grey, black, kaki or white, or unaltered Official Jason Hoodie sweatshirts (available through our School Store or ASB) may be worn in classrooms • Polo shirts or Official Jason Lee T-shirts must be worn under sweatshirts • No vests, fleece, quilted, or heavy outer-styles (all considered "outerwear") may be worn in classrooms unless permitted by principals; they must be stored in lockers • Students may wear outerwear to the cafeteria and outside to the fields/playgrounds during the lunch periods
<p>Other information</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes should be sneaker-type or flat shoes, and must be properly fastened at all times • No slippers, sandals or flip-flops (no backless or open toed shoes) • Shoes must be a matching pair • Socks and shoes are required at all times
<p>Not acceptable guidelines</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No tight, revealing clothing • No chains, or wallet chains are allowed • No studded belts, or spiked accessories are allowed • No clothing can be worn inside-out • No over-sized, baggy, sagging clothing • No rolled-up pants, and no tightening of pants around the ankles will be permitted • Gloves, hats, bandanas, sweatbands, hairnets, scarves, wristbands and sunglasses, etc. must be removed before entering the building and stored in lockers throughout the day • No writing is allowed on clothing or any part of the body • Backpacks, purses, and handbags must be stored in lockers throughout the day

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Students who do not wear appropriate clothing will have the choice of calling home for a change of clothes or using clean appropriate clothing from the school office, if available. They will not be allowed into class if not dressed properly, according to these standards and the judgment of the principals. The school reserves the right to determine if items not contained in this document are potentially dangerous or disruptive to the optimal educational atmosphere of the school.
