2011-2012 Uniform Guidelines

TOPS - Solid white, yellow, black or navy.

NO EMBLEMS, LOGOS, OR WRITING ON ANY TOPS.

1. All layers underneath must be solid yellow, white or black with no writing or emblems.
2. No sleeveless tops, spaghetti straps, tank tops, or low cut tops.
3. Only approved Lister school logos on shirts.
4. All sweatshirts are allowed but must be in solid uniform colors.

BOTTOMS - Solid black, navy, denim jeans, or tan/khaki

NO EMBLEMS, LOGOS, OR WRITING ON ANY PANTS.

1. Pants, Slacks, Corduroys, and Capri Pants
 - a. Jeans must be plain, with nothing on the pockets and no décor on them.
 - b. No more than one size larger than the waist.
 - c. Standard length and hemmed to the top of the shoe; no dragging on the floor.
 - d. Must be worn at the waist.
 - e. No athletic nylon pants or shorts.
2. Skirts, Shorts, and Skorts
 - a. Length - no shorter than 3" above the knee
 - b. Worn at the waist

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UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES

1. Oversized, baggy, or sagging clothing.
2. Chains hooked to wallets, belts, keys, or spiked accessories/jewelry.
3. Stretch pants, overalls, sweat pants, spandex, or nylon pants.
4. Tight or revealing clothing that may expose the bare torso or undergarments.
5. Any clothing or items advertising alcohol, drugs, tobacco, violence, vandalism, bigotry, sexual innuendoes, vulgarity, or double meanings.
6. Hats, caps, berets, bandanas, gloves, or hairnets.
7. No hair dye of any kind.
8. No sandals, flip-flops, or open-toed shoes.

ADDITIONAL UNIFORM GUIDELINES

1. Students are to arrive and leave school grounds in the school uniform.
2. No jackets or coats will be allowed in the classrooms or the building during the school day.

Protocol for Student Uniforms:

- 1st Offense: Student calls home for change of clothing.
- 2nd Offense: Student calls home for change of clothing AND a letter sent home with an offer of resources.
- 3rd Offense: Conference with the parent.
