Get started: Select a Lesson Accelerator and give it a try.

- **Select by type:** Do you want your students to give a presentation? Select an LA with "Presentation" in the Type column. It may not be for your subject area, but your students will learn basic skills using presentation software that they can apply to other subject content.
- **Select by subject:** [Download a list of LAs that are sorted by subject](#) and then choose the one you want by Title. But remember, most Lesson Accelerators can be adapted to fit other subjects.
